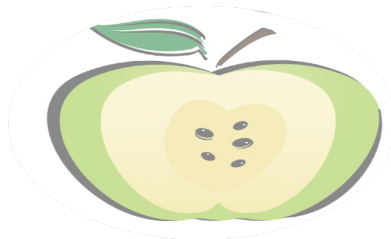

Punch It Card

What Is It?

The CORE Punch It Card is an upgrade to your CORE membership. Every Punch It Card is worth over \$105, but only costs \$25 each. Each \$25 Punch It Card has several apples on it that can be punched when an item from the Punch It Card section has been chosen. See the sample card below.



How Does It Work?

Items in the Punch It Card section of CORE are all brand new items. The items in the Punch It Card section are educational, crafty, or office type items. They have been organized by size. There are Large items, Medium items, and Small items. Each Punch It Card has 3 Large, 9 Medium, and 30 Small items to punch. You can pick out as many or as few items as you need. Each item will be punched instead of purchased.



Does the Punch It Card Expire?

The CORE Punch It Card never expires. Once you have purchased your Punch It Card, you can take as long as you would like to punch each item on the card. The Punch It Card items will change every few months. If you don't see an item you need, stop back another time and see if the new items are what you desire. If there are particular items you would like, let us know and we will try to get those items included in our Punch It Card section.
